QUICKSTRIP

CONCENTRATED EMULSION FLOOR POLISH STRIPPER



A fast acting emulsion polish stripper containing alkalis and penetrating agents for the effective break up and removal of the heaviest layers of floor polish. Can also be used for spray-stripping; Used to remove emulsion polishes from vinyl, wood, linoleum, stone and marble.

HOW TO USE

Floor Stripping

- QUICKSTRIP must be diluted before use using a 30ml 5lt pelican pump. Dilute between 5 and 10 parts of water depending upon degree of historical floor polish build up.
- Mop the solution onto the floor and allow 10-15 minutes contact time to penetrate the polish before agitating the floor with a low-speed floor machine fitted with a black or green stripping pad.
- Allow a further 10-15 minutes contact time, taking care not to allow the polish slurry to dry out.
- Remove all of the slurry from the floor with a wet pick-up machine or mop, ensuring that no slurry remains.
- Using clean water, damp mop the floor thoroughly to ensure that any remaining residues of stripper or slurry are removed.
- Allow the floor to dry before applying new coats of seal or polish.

Spray Stripping:

- To remove polish top coats dilute with up to 20 parts of water (1 plunge of the dispenser added to a 600ml spray bottle). Spray a fine mist over the floor, a few square metres at a time, and scrub the area with a machine fitted with a stripping pad.
- Remove any residue with a wet pick-up machine or by mopping.
- Damp mop the floor thoroughly and allow to dry before applying new polish.
